Who may participate?

1. All children attending school during the year 2010.
 2. There are three categories for the different age groups:
 - **Category 1. Elementary Phase: Age 6 years to 9 years**
 - **Category 2. Intermediate Phase: Age 10 years to 14 years**
 - **Category 3. Senior Phase: Age 15 years to Grade 12**

CATEGORY 1. Elementary Phase. Age 6 to 9 years.

DRAWING AND COLOURING COMPETITION

For this category the youngest participant should be 6 years old on 01 January 2010 and the eldest must have turned 9 on or before 31 December 2010. Participants may use different types of crayons (wax crayons, pencil crayons, pastel crayons etc) or a combination thereof. Creative imagination is the key to this category. SIZE OF PAPER / BOARD A3 or A2

CATEGORY 2. Intermediate Phase. Age 10 to 14 years.

DRAWING AND COLOURING COMPETITION

The youngest participant should be 10 years on or after 01 January 2010 and the eldest must have turned 14 on or before 30 December 2010. Participants are expected to draw/paint a visual art work where they interpret the theme **“SOUTH AFRICA WELCOMES GREECE INTO 2010 FIFA WORLD CUP™”**. (Any means on paper or board may be used). SIZE OF PAPER / BOARD A3 or A2.

CATEGORY 3. Senior Phase. Age 15 to Grade 12

DRAWING AND COLOURING COMPETITION

The youngest participant should be in 15 years old on or after 01 January 2010 and the eldest must be in Grade 12 in 2010. Participants are expected to draw/paint a visual art work where they interpret the theme **“SOUTH AFRICA WELCOMES GREECE INTO 2010 FIFA WORLD CUP™”** (Any means on paper or board may be used). SIZE OF PAPER / BOARD A3 or A2.

Interpretation of the Theme

In Ancient Greece people gathered for competitive sports called the “Stade”. The word “stadium” comes from that word. This tradition lives on in the magnificent stadiums build in South Africa for the FIFA 2010 WORLD Cup. This art competition offers you the opportunity to explore the theme **“SOUTH AFRICA WELCOMES GREECE INTO 2010 FIFA WORLD CUP™”** Participants should interpret the theme with a wide variety of ideas including elements that relate to the history, geography, sports arts and culture of South Africa and Greece. An example of this would be a picture of a *Greek football player holding the South African flag whilst standing in the midst of Soccer City. Behind him is a crowd holding a banner which reads: “Proudly South African”*.
